WATER SAVING TIPS FOR SUMMER

- ⇒ Chill drinking water in the refrigerator rather than running the tap until it runs cold;
- ⇒ Displace some of the water in toilet tanks with plastic bottle full of water. Install early closing flapper valves in older toilets;
- ⇒ Take shorter showers, you can save 2,600 litres(700 gallons) of water per month;
- ⇒ Use water-wise plants. Native & adaptive plants will use less water & be resistant to local plant diseases and pests. Choose drought tolerant plants whenever possible;
- ⇒ When you cut your lawn, leave it at least six centimetres(2 ½") long to provide shade for the roots. This will allow the soil to remain moist & require less watering;
- ⇒ Collect rain water in an old barrel or other large container that is outfitted with a spigot and a suitable cover, & use the water on your garden;
- ⇒ Using a running hose to wash your car can waste about 400 litres of water. Using a bucket with a sponge plus a trigger nozzle on the hose will save you about 300 of those litres;
- ⇒ Use fountains & similar yard ornaments that recycle water;
- ⇒ Water at the coolest time of day to reduce evaporation;
- ⇒ Be sure your hose has an automatic shutoff nozzle to ensure water is not wasted when the hose is left unattended.
